Chick

- ☐ **Rnd 1:** Using yellow Easy Does It Yarn create a magic circle and work 6 single crochets into it. Place a stitch marker in the last stitch made. **(6)**
- ☐ **Rnd 2:** Work 2 single crochets in each stitch around. Move stitch marker to last stitch in this round. **(12)**
- ☐ **Rnd 3:** [single crochet in first stitch, 2 single crochets in next stitch] 6 times. Move stitch marker to last stitch made. **(18)**
- ☐ **Rnd 4:** [single crochet in first stitch, 2 single crochets in next stitch, single crochet in next stitch] 6 times. Move stitch marker to last stitch made. **(24)**
- ☐ **Rnd 5-7:** single crochet in each stitch around. Move stitch marker to last stitch made **(24)**
- ☐ **Rnd 8:** [single crochet in first stitch, single crochet 2 stitches together, single crochet in next stitch] 6 times. Move stitch marker to last stitch made **(18)**
- ☐ **Rnd 9:** single crochet in each stitch around. Move stitch marker to last stitch made. **(18)**
- ☐ **Rnd 10:** [single crochet in first stitch, single crochet two stitches together] 6 times. Move stitch marker to last stitch made. **(12)**
- ☐ **Rnd 11:** single crochet in each stitch around. Move stitch marker to last stitch made **(12)** Stuff your chick with stuffing about $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way full.
- ☐ **Rnd 12:** single crochet two stitches together 6 times **(6)**. Place eyes 4 stitches apart about 3 rounds down from the top. Using the yarn needle, sew in the beak between the eyes using orange Easy Does It Yarn. Sew the opening closed and sew on a tuft of hair using fluffy white yarn.

Mama Hen

- ☐ **Rnd 1:** Using the white Easy Does It Yarn, create a magic circle and work 8 single crochets in it. You are going to work in continuous rounds so place a stitch marker in the last stitch created of each round so you don't lose your place. **(8 stitches worked in this round)**
- ☐ **Rnd 2:** Work 2 single crochets in each stitch around. Move stitch marker to last stitch made **(16)**
- ☐ **Rnd 3:** [single crochet in first stitch, 2 single crochets in next stitch] repeat 8 times. Move stitch marker to last stitch made **(24)**
- ☐ **Rnd 4:** [single crochet in first stitch, 2 single crochets in next stitch, single crochet in next stitch] repeat 8 times. Move stitch marker to last stitch made **(32)**
- ☐ **Rnd 5:** [single crochet in first 3 stitches, 2 single crochets in next stitch] repeat 8 times. Move stitch marker to last stitch made **(40)**
- ☐ **Rnd 6:** [single crochet in first 2 stitches, 2 single crochets in next stitch, single crochet in next 2 stitches] repeat 8 times. Move stitch marker to last stitch made **(48)**
- ☐ **Rnd 7-20:** Single crochet in each stitch around. Move stitch marker to last stitch made **(48)**

To make the head:

- ☐ **Rnd 21:** single crochet in first 9 stitches, skip next 30 stitches, single crochet in next 9 stitches. Move stitch marker to last stitch made **(18)**



- ☐ **Rnd 22:** single crochet in each stitch around. Move stitch marker to last stitch made **(18)**
- ☐ **Rnd 23:** [single crochet in next stitch, single crochet 2 stitches together] 6 times. Move stitch marker to last stitch made **(12)**
- ☐ **Rnd 24:** single crochet 2 stitches together 6 times **(6)**
- ☐ Tie off, leaving a tail to sew the top closed.

For the red comb:

- ☐ Get the red Easy Does It Yarn. Make a slip knot and attach it to the hen's head by inserting your hook and pulling the loop through. [Chain 4, 2 single crochets in 3rd chain from hook, slip stitch into head] Repeat 2 more times. Tie off and tuck the ends into the hen.
- ☐ Place eyes and using the yarn needle make the beak using the orange Easy Does It Yarn. Stuff the hen and stitch the back closed.

Egg

To make the bottom part of the egg:

- ☐ **Rnd 1:** Using white Easy Does It Yarn, create a magic circle and work 6 single crochets in it. Place a stitch marker in the last stitch made. **(6)**
- ☐ **Rnd 2:** 2 single crochets in each stitch around. Move stitch marker to last stitch made **(12)**
- ☐ **Rnd 3:** [single crochet in first stitch, 2 single crochets in next stitch] repeat 6 times. Move stitch marker to last stitch made **(18)**
- ☐ **Rnd 4:** [single crochet in first stitch, 2 single crochets in next stitch, single crochet in next stitch] repeat 6 times. Move stitch marker to last stitch made **(24)**
- ☐ **Rnd 5-9:** single crochet in each stitch around **(24)**. Tie off. This is the bottom half of the egg.

To make the upper part of the egg:

- ☐ **Rnd 1:** Using white Easy Does It Yarn, create a magic circle and work 6 single crochets in it. Place a stitch marker in the last stitch made. **(6)**
- ☐ **Rnd 2:** 2 single crochets in each stitch around. Move stitch marker to last stitch made. **(12)**
- ☐ **Rnd 3:** [single crochet in first 3 stitches, 2 single crochets in next stitch] repeat 3 times. Move stitch marker to last stitch made. **(15)**
- ☐ **Rnd 4:** [single crochet in first 4 stitches, 2 single crochets in next stitch] repeat 3 times. Move stitch marker to last stitch made. **(18)**
- ☐ **Rnd 5:** [single crochet in first stitch, 2 single crochets in next stitch, single crochet in next stitch] repeat 6 times. Move stitch marker to last stitch made. **(24)**
- ☐ **Rnd 6-8:** single crochet in each stitch around (24). Tie off. This is the bottom half of the egg. Leave a long tail and sew the two halves together. Weave in ends
