(without abbreviations)


PLEASE NOTE: The number in parentheses at the end of each round is the number of stitches in that round. These instructions are intended to be followed along while watching the videos.

Mama Hen Rnd 1: Using the white Easy Does It Yarn, create a magic circle and work 8 single crochets in it. You are going to work in continuous rounds so place a stitch marker in the last stitch created of each round so you don't lose your place. (8) stitches worked in this round) Rnd 2: Work 2 single crochets in each stitch around. Move stitch marker to last stitch made (16) Rnd 3: [single crochet in first stitch, 2] single crochets in next stitch] repeat 8 Rnd 22: single crochet in each stitch times. Move stitch marker to last stitch around. Move stitch marker to last stitch made *(24)* made (18) Rnd 4: [single crochet in first stitch, 2 Rnd 23: [single crochet in next stitch, single crochets in next stitch, single single crochet 2 stitches together] 6 times. crochet in next stitch] repeat 8 times. [Chain 4, 2 single crochets in around. Move stitch marker to last stitch 3rd chain from hook, slip stitch into head] made (48) Repeat 2 more times. Tie off and tuck the ends into the hen. To make the head: Place eyes and using the yarn needle Rnd 21: single crochet in first 9 stitches, make the beak using the orange Easy skip next 30 stitches, single crochet in Does It Yarn. Stuff the hen and stitch the next 9 stitches. Move stitch marker to last back closed. stitch made (18)

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last stitch made (24) Rnd 5-9: single crochet in each stitch around (24). Tie off. This is the bottom half of the egg.
